INTRODUCTION TO THE CNED (Secondary school)

The CNED, Centre National d'Enseignement à distance, is an organization of the French Department of National Education.

This very reliable organization proposes school programs of an excellent level for primary school (from the grand section of preschool to medium course 2) and secondary school (from the 6th level to the Baccalauréat).

The content of the educational training is conforming to the official French programs.

In each domain, the course is divided in 12 sequences.

All the domains are evaluated at the end of each sequence or every 2 sequences.

A teacher from the National Education in France sends a personal correction for each written or oral evaluation. He also evaluates the competences acquired.

At the end of the school year, the parents will also receive an assessment of the competences acquired.

The EFH and the CNED

Thanks to the CNED, the EFH is a school which offers to the pupils a high quality teaching conforming to the programs of the French National Education.

The EFH provides children with:

- a welcoming and secured place of life
- a place of socialisation (exchanges and cultures)
- a place of studying (learning and knowledge)
- a place of development (intelligence and personality)
- A native French speaking teacher is responsible for each classroom. The teacher helps the children to learn with the CNED while offering the advantages of a direct and humane teaching
